1. The Maternal Child Health Network begins a “Cribs for Kids” project supplying cribs to needy families in Lake County, IN
2. HealthVisions Midwest became the manager of the 1.5 million dollar grant for the 4Community Implementation Project. The grant was made possible by the Lily Endowment to the Indiana Association of United Ways through the Lake, Porter, and LaPorte United Ways. Eleven mini-grants were given to projects that will reduce weight and improve the health of adults and children.
3. Sharon McGuire joined the HVM team in the role of Director of Human Resources and Nureya Miller began her role as staff accountant.
4. HVM began a new collaboration with St. Joseph Medical Center in South Bend by helping to fund a medical mobile unit at sites in Plymouth and Mishawaka serving the Hispanic population.
5. O’Hana, in Mishawaka, a respite home for medically fragile children received their corporation status. HVM initially managed their funds and aide them in becoming their own corporation.
