1. “Health from the Garden” a project teaching children gardening and nutrition was established at the following sites: Center for Homeless in South Bend, Tradewinds YMCA and Boys and Girls clubs, in Lake County, Schools in Knox and a number of churches in Fort Wayne. This program was a partnership with Purdue University Extension Services and the Indiana Department of Health.
2. Health Ministry Partnership received a \$7000 grant from Trinity Health to participate in a study to document the maintaining and promotion of independence among at-risk seniors.
3. Living for Life the partnership of HVM and Starke Memorial hospital sponsored their first County baby shower for 50 at risk pregnant women.
4. HealthVisions Fort Wayne began a “Home Support Exercise Program” providing exercises for homebound older adults to help them improve endurance, balance strength and flexibility.
5. Robert Wood Johnson foundation provided funds for Renetta Williams, Mary Rooney and Judith Rice to attend the National Faith in action Conference in Washington, DC
